Dear Friends,  
As Thanksgiving approaches, we would do well to think about the sacrifices others have made for us. These sacrifices, material and spiritual, may well have sustained us in our needs and comforted us in our troubles. As we come together today, let us ask ourselves what sacrifices we can make for our family members, our friends, and our neighbors. What sacrifices might the Lord be asking us to make?

**THIS WEEK'S SCRIPTURE LESSON:** Each reading today tells of someone who sacrificed the very last thing they could offer. The widow who welcomes Elijah sacrifices her last grains of flour and last drops of oil to bake bread for this stranger. The widow Jesus sees outside the temple sacrifices two small coins, her whole livelihood, to the temple treasury. The author of Hebrews points out that Jesus sacrificed his very life for our sins. As we listen to scripture today, let us think about what we ourselves are willing to sacrifice.

**STEWARDSHIP:** The story of the widow's mite makes a very strong point: it is not the amount that we give that is important, but the way that we give. Stewardship calls us to give of our substance not our abundance. Mature disciples make a conscious decision to follow Jesus, no matter what the cost.

**A REMINDER:** On this Veterans Day weekend, let us take pause and remember the noble men and women who through the centuries have stepped forward to offer their lives in defense of the freedoms and liberties we enjoy. Let us never forget their sacrifices. This weekend we will also be commissioning the new and renewing Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion at both Masses at St. Augustine.

**A QUESTION FOR THE WEEK:** Last week we heard that love of God and love of neighbor are the first of all the commandments. Today we hear three examples of sacrifice. What are we willing to sacrifice for God and for our neighbor?

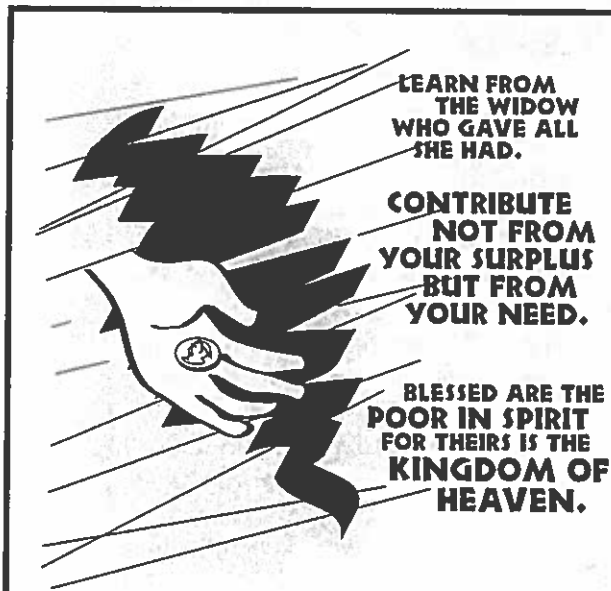

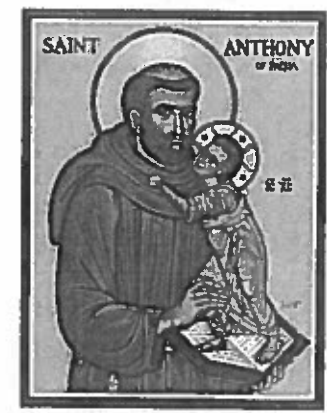
