Dear Friends,
 The month of November is the time when the Church traditionally recalls those who have gone before us. We mourn their loss, we pray for their souls, we hope to be reunited with them when we ourselves die. As it is the end of the liturgical year (it will begin anew in two weeks with Advent), we also bring to mind the end of time. Though we cannot know the day nor the hour, our trust and hope is in the Lord.

THIS WEEK'S SCRIPTURE LESSON: The readings today focus on the end of time. Daniel prophesies about the resurrection of those who have already died, a radical notion in his day. The author of Hebrews emphasizes that Jesus' sacrifice on the cross atoned for all sins, for all people, for all time. In Mark, Jesus warns his disciples of the terrible signs of the end of time but reassures them that God's elect will be gathered from the ends of the earth. May these promises allow us to face the future with hope.

STEWARDSHIP: As a result of God's generosity and love for us, He sent His only Son, Jesus, to die for us. Jesus calls us, his disciples, to a new way of life - the Christian way of life - of which stewardship is a part. Our stewardship should mirror God's generosity.

A REMINDER: As we prepare for Thanksgiving Day on Thursday, see the Partnership Mass schedule, so that you may spend some time as a family in gratitude to a loving and generous God who provides for all our needs. Also please join in the Thanksgiving Ecumenical service that will take place on Tuesday, November 20 at 7pm in the Beckemeyer United Methodist Church - "All Are Welcome".

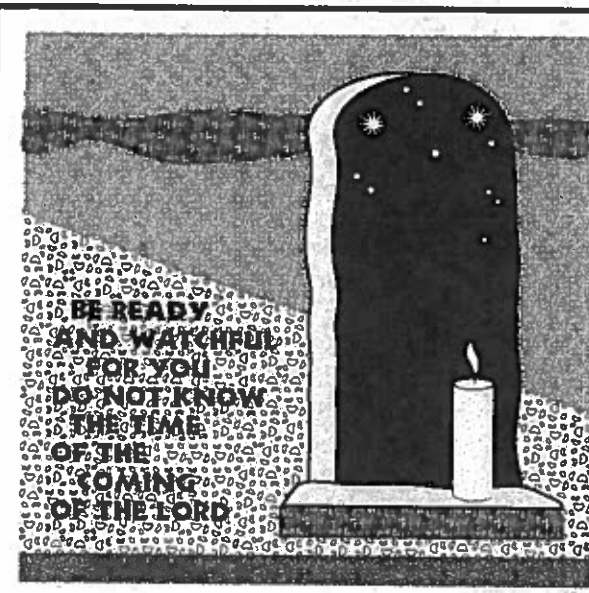

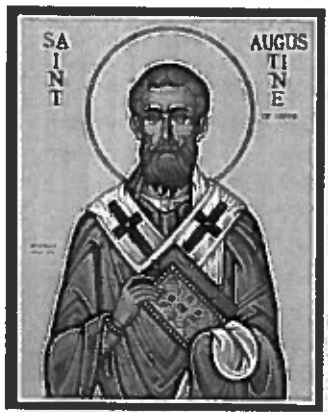

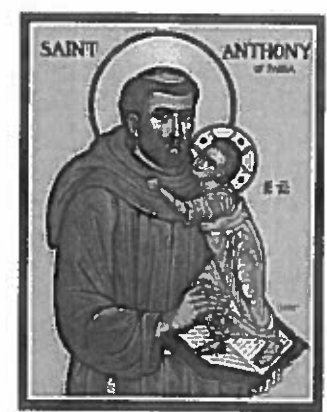
