Dear Friends,
We gather today, as we do every Sunday, as the Body of Christ. We are called to be Christ in the world through our words and actions. Saint Paul teaches us that we are called to be parts of Christ's body. Individually we are many parts, but together we are one. As we begin to observe Catholic Schools Week today, let Paul's words provide a valuable lesson for us to learn.

THIS WEEK'S SCRIPTURE LESSON: Last week Jesus began his ministry in John's Gospel by changing water into wine at a wedding in Cana. Today he begins his ministry in Luke's Gospel by preaching at his synagogue in Nazareth. Ironically, the passage he was to read summed up his mission. "Today," Jesus said, "this Scripture passage is fulfilled in your hearing." Today, as members of the Body of Christ, we are called to continue to fulfill Christ's mission. Let us discover what we are called to do.

STEWARDSHIP: Stewardship plays an important role in the lives of people who seek to follow Christ. We must be stewards of our personal vocations. In addition, we have a duty to be stewards of our Church: that community of disciples, that Body of Christ, of which we, individually and together, are the members, and in which "if one part suffers, all parts suffer with it; if one member is honored, all the members share its joy."

A REMINDER: Sunday we begin Catholic Schools Week with its theme of: "Learn, Serve, Lead, Succeed." We are most fortunate to have both All Saints Catholic Academy and Mater Dei Catholic High School which serve our parishes and local communities. Catholic education has always been a primary Ministry of the Catholic Church in America. Let us be grateful for all the Religious Women, Brothers, Priests and Laypeople who have sacrificed to make Catholic education accountable, available, affordable and accessible.

A QUESTION FOR THE WEEK: Am I conscious of Jesus' presence in our midst? How do I show others that I am part of the Body of Christ?

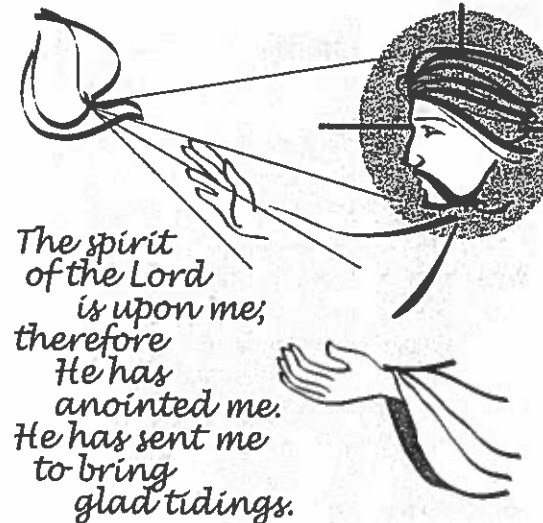

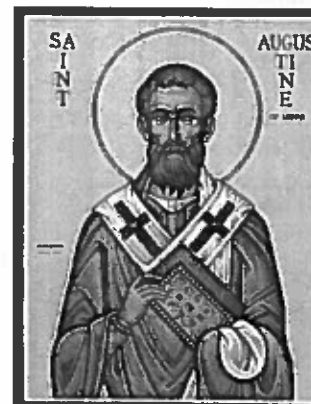
Reconciliation: Seasonal penance services offered throughout the year, on Saturday at 3:30 pm at St. Augustine Church or by appointment at any time.

We invite everyone 18 or older to register at the office as adults.

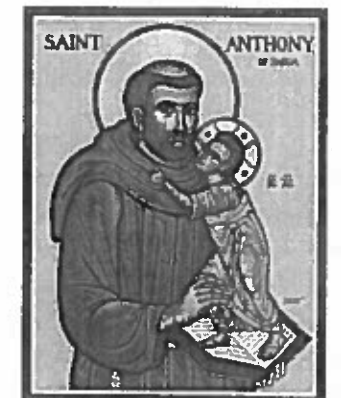
