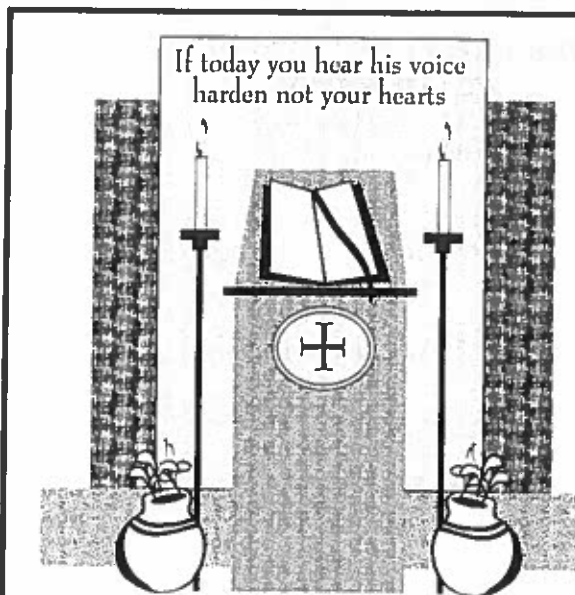

Baptism: Celebrated after the weekend Liturgies by appointment. Baptismal preparation class required. Contact the parish office to register.

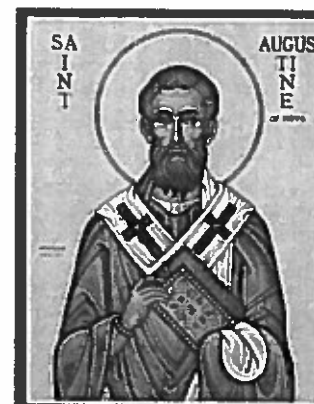
Reconciliation: Seasonal penance services offered throughout the year, on Saturday at 3:30 pm at St. Augustine Church or by appointment at any time.

Dear Friends,
On the last two Sundays we heard Jesus calling his first disciples. Over the next three Sundays, we will hear stories of Jesus healing the sick and afflicted. He is just beginning his public ministry but as he drives out demons and heals lepers, his renown and his popularity increase quickly. In today's Gospel, Jesus drives out an unclean spirit. The people are astonished, not just at his actions, but also how he taught with such authority.

THIS WEEK'S SCRIPTURE LESSON: In the first reading we hear God promise Moses that God will raise up a prophet like him "and will put my words into his mouth." Mark then presents Jesus as being that prophet. He astonishes the people of Capernaum by teaching at the synagogue with authority, then encountering a man with an unclean spirit and immediately driving the unclean spirit out by his command.

STEWARDSHIP: Medical surveys correlating physical health and social activities consistently attest that those who perform regular volunteer work have death rates two and one-half times lower than those who do not. The surest way to be free of all worries is to invest our time and talent in the service of others.

A REMINDER: As we begin Catholic School's Week and celebrate its theme: "Catholic Schools: Learn. Serve. Lead. Succeed", let us be grateful as a community to have the opportunity to choose a Catholic Pre-school, Kindergarten, Primary, Elementary and Secondary education for our children. We are truly blessed to have All Saints Academy and Mater Dei Catholic High School with their dedicated, faithful and committed faculties and staffs. Next weekend, we will have a second collection for the benefit of Sr. Thea Bowman Catholic School, whose students will be with us at the 4pm Mass at St. Augustine to play their violins and sing.

A QUESTION FOR THE WEEK: What kinds of "unclean spirits" afflict the world today? Do I risk becoming unclean myself when encountering the evils that surround me? What can I do to overcome that risk?

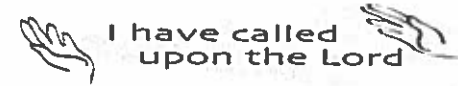
