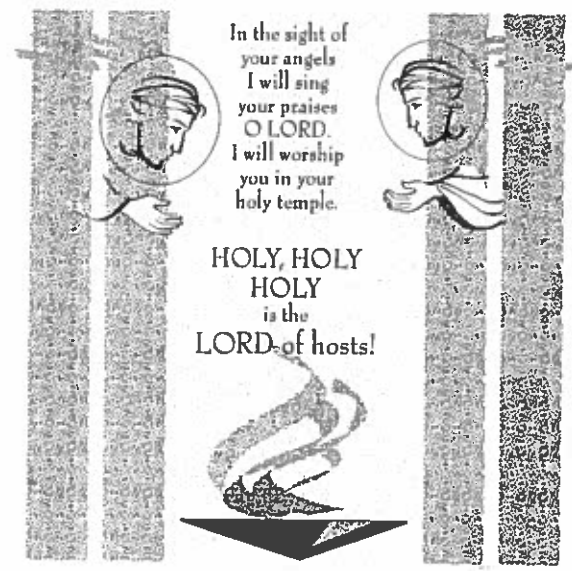

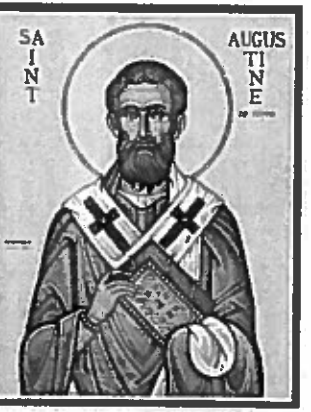
Baptism: Celebrated after the weekend Liturgies by appointment. Baptismal preparation class required. Contact the parish office to register.

Anointing: Annually offered at Mass or as needed. Call the parish office.

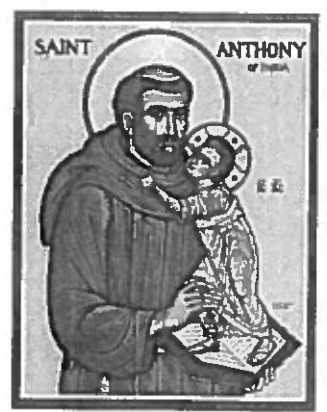



We are called to be disciples of Jesus. It is not enough just to believe; we are asked to take up our crosses and follow him. We are challenged to make sacrifices. THIS WEEK'S SCRIPTURE LESSON: An unlikely thread links the three people who are called to be disciples in today's readings: all pronounce themselves unworthy. Isaiah, Paul, and Peter are saints and prophets, but each sees himself first as a sinner. As we listen to the readings today, let us realize that even though we too are unworthy, God still calls us to be disciples.

STEWARDSHIP: All gifts are given to us by the God who makes all things new. We are called to be good stewards of all God has given us -- family, time, wealth, energy, life. Disciples who practice Stewardship recognize God as the Origin of life, the Giver of freedom, the Source of all they have and are and will be. Stewards know themselves to be recipients and caretakers of God's many gifts. They are grateful for what they have received and eager to cultivate their gifts out of love for God and one another.

A REMINDER: Tuesday we celebrate Lincoln's birthday. Few presidents have ever risen to the stature and nobility of "Honest Abe". He helped to reshape our Country through a turbulent time of division and taught us that all are God's children and deserve the dignity of being recognized as valued citizens. It is his legacy that makes us truly great and we must always strive to maintain that.

A QUESTION FOR THE WEEK: How am I called to transform my life? Have I already transformed my life and feel called to encourage others to do so as well?
