Dear Friends,

Just over a month ago we were still celebrating the Christmas season. In another few days we will begin the season of Lent. This section of Ordinary Time is quite compressed. But it gives us enough time to complete the first chapter of Mark, which we do today. We meet the leper who, cured of his leprosy, cannot keep quiet about what Jesus did for him. He provides an example of the believer testifying to Christ's power.

**THIS WEEK'S SCRIPTURE LESSON:** Leprosy features prominently in the first reading and the Gospel today. In Leviticus, the leper is kept outside the community so as to protect everyone else from this communicable disease. But the leper in Mark challenges Jesus and Jesus breaks down the barrier between them, reaches out, touches him, and heals him. As we listen to today's readings, consider how we exclude others in our lives, perhaps because we feel they would make us "unclean," and how Jesus would respond.

**STEWARDSHIP:** How often are we genuinely moved with pity? How many requests on our time, our talent, and our treasure do we leave unanswered? Stewardship calls us to share ourselves and our gifts with others generously as members of one Christian community. Christian stewards are generous out of love as well as duty. They grow in a spirit of mercy and charity.

**A REMINDER:** I will be leaving this afternoon to go to Chicago to prepare to catch a flight to the Holy Lands. I will be receiving a Pilgrim's Shell from the Patriarch of Jerusalem as part of my Knighthood in the Equestrian Order of the Holy Sepulchre of Jerusalem. I will also be joining other members of the Order on a pilgrimage to the Holy Sites. I will be returning on March 1st. Fr. Dennis Voss will be here for the Masses at both parishes on Ash Wednesday and the following two weekends. I will be keeping all of you in my prayers as I celebrate Mass where Jesus walked among us.

**A QUESTION FOR THE WEEK:** How can our compassion lead us to break barriers and bring healing to others, thereby giving glory to God?

**Anointing:** Annually offered at Mass or as needed. Call the parish office.

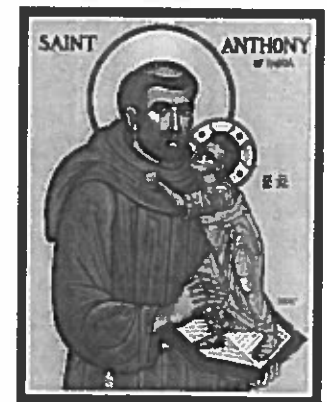
