Dear Friends,
 Expectations have a habit of tripping us up. We think we have it all figured out. We know what to expect. But then something happens to surprise us and we have to decide whether to believe it or not. Is this for real? The folks in Nazareth had expectations of their native son. This "son of Joseph" couldn't possibly be the Anointed One, could he? God has a habit of surprising us, of defying our expectations.

THIS WEEK'S SCRIPTURE LESSON: Jeremiah is called to preach God's word, but most of the first reading describes God fortifying him against the opposition he will face. Jesus meets opposition from his hometown and needs to move on. But in between we are treated to Saint Paul's rhapsody on love. The Corinthians were alternately jealous and dismissive of others' spiritual gifts. Paul preaches that love is more important than any spiritual gift, for without love nothing else matters.

STEWARDSHIP: From conception, God calls us, invites us to follow Jesus, and to make stewardship a way of life. In our modern world, the demands of faith can be ominous and onerous, as the first reading suggests. But Christian stewards, aware of themselves as co-creators with God and caretakers of all they have and are, develop a profound reverence for the gift of life and its fullness. Christian stewards are asked to become people who have a profound, personal commitment to cooperate with God in their own redemption and in the redemption of others.

A REMINDER: We are happy to have with us students from Sr. Thea Bowman Catholic Grade School in East St. Louis, who will be performing their musical talents at our 4pm Mass at St. Augustine this Saturday evening. As we welcome them let us also be generous in our response to a second collection that is being taken up to benefit their school. Sunday is also Boy Scout Sunday – we thank those who volunteer to provide a model for these young men.

A QUESTION FOR THE WEEK: Can I see the face of Jesus in someone I disagree with? Can I respond with love? Can that love bear all things, believe all things, hope all things, endure all things?
