Dear Friends,  
Today we continue hearing about the first days Jesus spent with his disciples, healing those who are ill or possessed by demons. When he cures Simon Peter's mother-in-law, she immediately rises and serves her guests. She may not realize it, but she is providing an example to her son-in-law and his companions. She is showing what it means to be a disciple of Jesus. The call to be Jesus' disciple is the call to serve.  
**THIS WEEK'S SCRIPTURE LESSON:** Our readings today progress from despair to hope. Job has lost his children, his livelihood, and his health. "I shall not see happiness again," he mourns in his lament to God. In the Gospel, "the whole town" came to Jesus, bringing those who were ill or possessed by demons. They wait patiently, filled with hope. Undoubtedly, we can picture ourselves in both situations. When we are in despair, let us remind ourselves of the healing grace of Jesus.  
**STEWARDSHIP:** In the responsorial psalm, we pray: "Praise the Lord, for God is good; sing praise to our God, for the Lord is gracious." (Psalm 147:1) The most important motive for giving is the recognition that God is good and gracious. Giving should always be thanksgiving. The Scriptures remind us that God loves a cheerful giver.  
**A REMINDER:** We welcome the students, their teachers and parents to our Mass at St. Augustine on Saturday. They will be playing their violins and singing. We also welcome any Scouts and Adult Leaders to our Masses on Sunday, as we commemorate Boy Scout Sunday this weekend.  
**A QUESTION FOR THE WEEK:** What does it mean to be a disciple? How do I serve God and serve others?

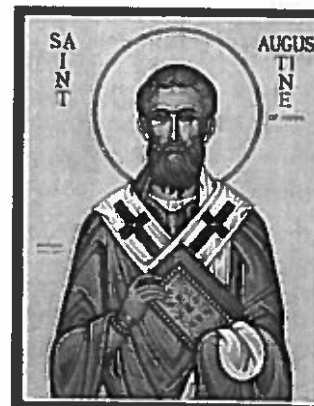
**Reconciliation:** Seasonal penance services offered throughout the year, on Saturday at 3:30 pm at St. Augustine Church or by appointment at any time.

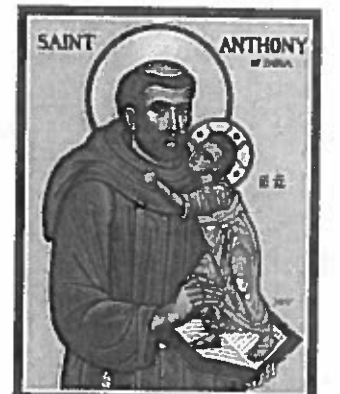
