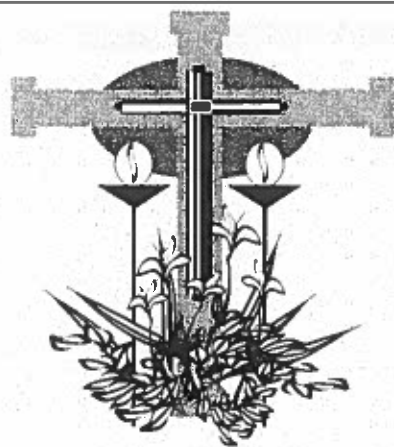

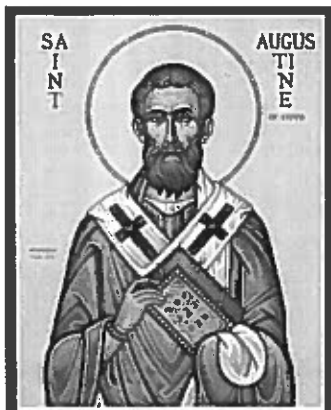
Reconciliation: Seasonal penance

Dear Friends,

Summer can be a difficult time for many, when extreme heat can contribute to wildfires and drought, heat-related illness and difficulty breathing. It is disturbing, then, to hear Jesus say in today's Gospel, "I have come to set the earth on fire!" Jesus' mission was as much to challenge as to comfort. As disciples, we are challenged to remain faithful, no matter the weather. Have we been set on fire in our commitment to our faith?

THIS WEEK'S SCRIPTURE LESSON: Jeremiah spoke truth to power and was nearly killed. Jesus admits he has come to sow discord; eventually he is crucified. But there is hope! Jeremiah was lifted out of the cistern. Jesus was raised from the dead. God will not abandon us. Let the words from Hebrews give us hope in the midst of our struggles: "Jesus endured such opposition ... in order that you may not grow weary and lose heart."

STEWARDSHIP: Today, the encumbrance of sin includes not just the quest for pleasure but avarice, a craving for the illusion of absolute dominion and control, valuing creatures without reference to their Creator, excessive individualism, and ultimately the fear of death unrelieved by hope for eternal life. But if we accept God's grace and, repenting, struggle to change, the Spirit of wisdom and courage will help us seek pardon and be mindful that the most important work of our lives is to be Jesus' disciples.

A REMINDER: As the new school year gets under way, let us keep our children in our prayers and ask the Lord to bless them with a grace filled and awesome learning experience.

A QUESTION FOR THE WEEK: When have I stood up for what is right? When would I be willing to do so?
