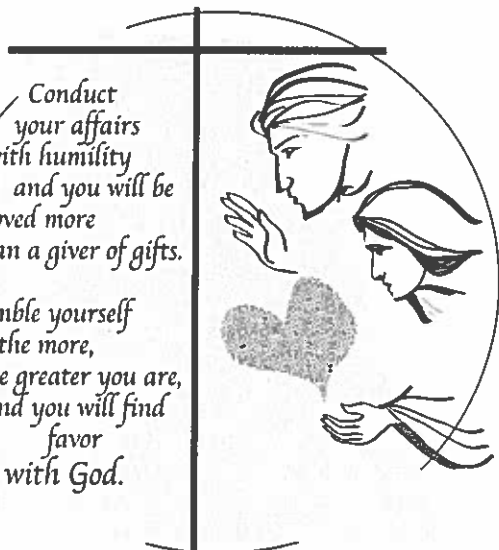

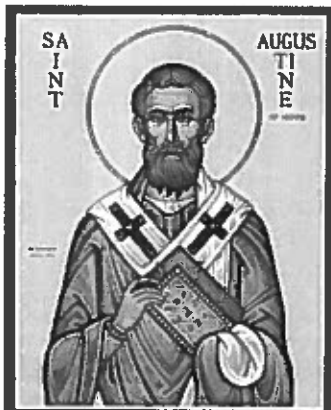
**Reconciliation:** Seasonal penance services offered throughout the year, on Saturday at 3:30 pm at St. Augustine Church or by appointment at any time.



Dear Friends,

We gather around the table of the Lord on this Labor Day weekend to share a meal. Everyone is invited! Regardless of race, gender, culture, background, class, identity, income, or any other unnecessary source of division, we join together to celebrate this Eucharistic banquet. As we listen to Jesus tell a parable about invitations to a banquet while he himself is a guest at a dinner, let us consider our hospitality toward others.

**THIS WEEK'S SCRIPTURE LESSON:** True humility requires that we acknowledge our weaknesses, our imperfections, our humanness. We are not more important than our neighbor. Sirach offers this as a lesson to guide the listener. Jesus tries to teach this to the Pharisees in the Gospel we hear today. Humility begets generosity, as it recognizes the value in our neighbor, especially those who are put down. True generosity is shown when giving to those who cannot repay.

**STEWARDSHIP:** More than any other gospel writer, St. Luke is concerned with Jesus' attitude toward the economically and socially poor. The message for the Christian steward is not to be blinded by present fortune. Recognize and appreciate the real value of God's kingdom. Jesus warns that in all blessings and woes, the present condition will be reversed in the future.

**A REMINDER:** As we look forward to Labor Day on Monday, let us ask the Lord to bless the work of our hands, the labor of our hearts and the tasks that lay before us.

**A QUESTION FOR THE WEEK:** I am invited to receive Jesus in the Eucharist, though I admit, "Lord, I am not worthy." Whom can I invite into my life; though they may be unworthy?
