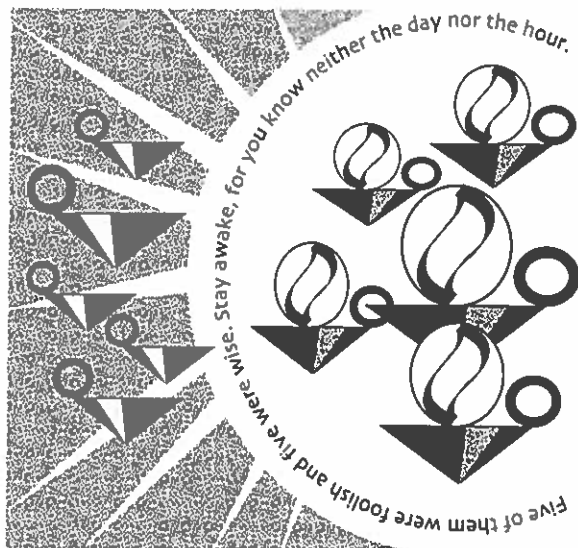

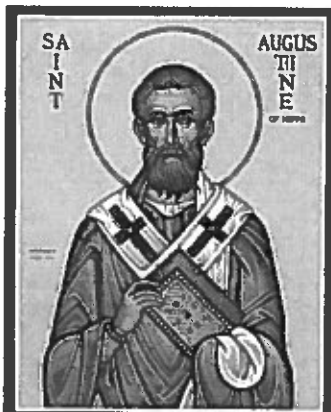
**Reconciliation:** Seasonal penance services offered throughout the year, on Saturday at 3:30 pm at St. Augustine Church or by appointment at any time.

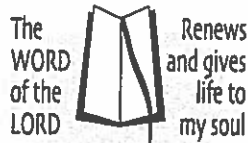

Dear Friends,

At the end of the liturgical year the readings focus upon the end times and the last judgment. This year, those themes begin today. We are reminded that we cannot know either the day or the hour. Therefore, we should always be prepared. Gathered together to celebrate the Eucharist today, let us consider our readiness for the Lord's coming at the end of time.

**THIS WEEK'S SCRIPTURE LESSON:** In today's Gospel, five wise virgins bring extra oil for their lamps so that they will remain burning well into the night, while five foolish virgins, having neglected to bring more oil, carry lamps that flicker out. The wisdom that the five foolish ones disregard was available to all who desired it, resplendent and unfading. Let us use that wisdom now as we listen to the word of God, considering what we can do to brighten the path to God's kingdom.

**STEWARDSHIP:** Today's parable of the ten bridesmaids reminds us that each of us is called to a stewardship of time. This should include setting aside periods for family prayer, for the reading of Scripture, for visits to the Blessed Sacrament, and for attendance at Mass during the week whenever this is possible. The steward must be ready to greet the master at a time of the master's choosing.

**A REMINDER:** We are happy to have with us at the 10am Sunday Mass at St. Augustine this weekend, the Breese Council Knights of Columbus, as they remember twelve deceased Brother Knights from this past Fraternal Year. May they Rest in Peace and may their memories be a Blessing.

Our special collection for the **Catholic Campaign for Human Development (CCHD)** will take place on **Nov. 21/22**. Forty million people in the United States live in poverty, including many in our diocese. This collection supports programs that empower people to identify and address the obstacles they face as they work to bring positive change to their communities. **25% of the collection stays in our diocese to fund local community and economic development projects in economically challenged areas.** Richland County CEO, one of our local CCHD grant recipients, teaches youth the skills needed to start their own local businesses and to build a healthy local economy. Schools and PSRs in our diocese also received grants totaling \$3,096 for Catholic Social Teaching and poverty education. The remaining amount of the collection goes to the CCHD national office to fund large grants throughout the nation. This year, over \$135,000 in national funding was given to groups in our diocese to create long lasting economic and community improvements. Please use the special envelope provided with your monthly envelopes or in your 2020 boxed contribution envelope set to offer your support.

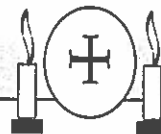
