Dear Friends,

On the Sea of Galilee, Simon and Andrew were fishing for fish when Jesus walked past, saying, "Come after me, and I will make you fishers of men," changing their lives forever. We hear stories of calls in the readings today: calls to follow, calls of conversion, calls to repentance, calls to discipleship. Let us take this opportunity today to listen closely and discern whether we can hear Jesus calling us to something more.

**THIS WEEK'S SCRIPTURE LESSON:** Jonah delivers a warning to Nineveh that their city will be destroyed in forty days. After only one day, the people listened and repented. In the Gospel, Jesus comes to Galilee with a call to repent and believe. Building a team committed to his mission, he invites four fishermen to follow him. Immediately they leave their work and families to do so. In between, we hear Paul, whose life was changed on the road to Damascus, calling the Corinthians to conversion. Let these readings inspire us to listen and respond.

**STEWARDSHIP:** St. Paul's comments are the perfect introduction to how we should approach this year as faithful Stewards. We are all called to work in the world without getting caught up in the cares and concerns of the world. We are called to possess lightly, to manage our affairs prudently without forgetting that we own nothing. It all belongs to God.

**A <u>Reminder</u>**: We find ourselves in the midst of Winter in what the Church calls "Ordinary Time." It is really difficult to think of any time that is spent in the Lord's presence as being "ordinary." God provides us with an abundance of His "Extraordinary" Presence – we just have to be willing to experience Him and let Him influence and change our lives for the better. <u>A QUESTION FOR THE WEEK</u>: The kingdom of God is at hand, within reach. How can I answer God's call and commit myself to help realize the kingdom of God here and now?
