



Dear Friends.

"Love one another," Jesus tells his disciples. No, Jesus commands his disciples. This is how everyone will know that they are his disciples. As we gather here today, we ask ourselves if we can be recognized by our love. Do we show the love we have for one another in what we do and say? Do we love one another as much as Jesus loves us? May the God of love bless us in the challenge to love each other.

This Week's Scripture Lesson: The first reading may read like a travelogue of the ancient Gentile world, but in between all the place names we hear the care Paul and Barnabas took in calling disciples and building up the early church. They take to heart Jesus' command to his disciples in the Gospel: love one another. Paralleling the way the region and the church are being remade through the work of Paul and Barnabas is John's vision of God creating a new heaven and earth, uniting the two in this new world. Listening to God's word, let us appreciate how God's grace makes all things new.

**STEWARDSHIP:** As members of the Church, Jesus calls us to be disciples. A mature disciple is one who: has a deep sense of identity and destiny; has the ability to love, whatever the cost, and to be loved, whatever the vulnerability; and exercises Christian Stewardship. Disciples can name their gifts, take ownership for them; and accept responsibility for what God has given us and the circumstances of our times.

<u>A REMINDER</u>: As we enter the final weeks of the school year, we extend congratulations to all the graduates from the various levels of their educational advancement and ask the Lord to keep them safe over the Summer break.



#### **Youth Ministry**


