Dear Friends,

We continue to celebrate the Easter season today, this fifty-day celebration of the risen Lord's victory over the grave. It stretches from Easter Sunday itself to Pentecost Sunday, when we mark the day when the Holy Spirit came down upon the first apostles. At the Last Supper Jesus told his disciples that he and the Father would make their dwelling with them and send the Holy Spirit to remind them of everything he taught them. Let us rejoice this Easter season for God's abiding presence with us.

**THIS WEEK'S SCRIPTURE LESSON:** Each of today's readings looks toward the future while assuring us of God's continuing presence with us. The apostles rely on the Holy Spirit to guide them as to which Mosaic practices are necessary for all Christians. The author of Revelation envisions a new Jerusalem, radiant in the glory of God. In the Gospel, Jesus tells his disciples that the Father would send the Holy Spirit to teach them, to remind them of his words, and to advocate for them. In the presence of the Spirit, let us listen to God's word.

**STEWARDSHIP:** God's greatest gift to us was His Son Jesus. His gift was intentional and sacrificial, expressing His unconditional love for us. As Christians we believe that all we have and all we are comes from God - we are caretakers of His gifts. We can give thanks to God for all He has given us by sharing these gifts out of love for Him and one another.

**A REMINDER:** As the colors of Spring begin to change to the foliage of Summer, and we feel the increasing warmth of the Sun, let us think of the beauty of what Heaven must be like, knowing the splendor of such magnificence of Creation here.

This weekend we are recognizing our Confirmandi at our two parishes this Sunday.

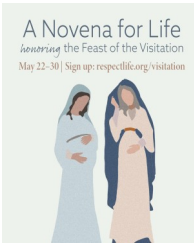
