



Dear Friends,

Today we hear our forebears in faith invite others to share a meal and fellowship with them. Abraham and Sarah welcome three strangers and insist they rest and eat. Martha and Mary welcome Jesus into their home, where Martha takes care of all the serving while Mary visits with him. Here today we too are invited to listen to God's word and share a meal. Let us give thanks to God for this wonderful hospitality.

THIS WEEK'S SCRIPTURE LESSON: Abraham invites three passing strangers to stay and rest before they continue their journey. They reveal a surprise to Sarah, who is preparing food behind the scenes. In the Gospel, sisters Martha and Mary invite the Lord into their home, Martha serving him as Mary visits with him. Let us invite the Lord into our hearts now as we listen to God's word, praying, like Paul in the second reading, that the word of God may be brought to completion for us.

STEWARDSHIP: Jesus is the supreme teacher of Christian stewardship, as He is of every other aspect of Christian life. He not only restores to good order the created household of God which sin has disrupted, but also, in calling disciples, commissions and empowers them as stewards of His Church to collaborate with Him in the work of redemption for themselves and on behalf of others.

<u>A REMINDER</u>: "Hospitality" and "Welcoming" go hand in hand. A Faith Community must always be a place where individuals, whether parishioners or strangers who join us, feel at ease and safe within the environment. That environment is enhanced by the prayerfulness of the people gathered and lends toward our encounter with Jesus in the Eucharist.

<u>A QUESTION FOR THE WEEK</u>: Am I hospitable to others, to those in need of food and rest, or just in need of company? Do I see the Lord in those in need?
