



Dear Friends,

"Make straight his paths," Isaiah cried out, prophesying that the LORD would come to rescue and comfort the people of God. Centuries later, Mark quotes this call at the very beginning of his Gospel, presenting John the Baptist as the prophet who took this to heart, preparing the way for the Lord. Now, two millennia later, during this season when we prepare for the Lord's coming into our lives and into our hearts, how can we "make straight his paths"?

THIS WEEK'S SCRIPTURE LESSON: In today's first reading, it is in the desert that Isaiah imagines a way of the LORD will be prepared. In the Gospel, it is from the desert that John the Baptist appears on the scene. Hearing these prophets today, let us contemplate our own spiritual deserts and listen for John's call for repentance. May we heed that call as we prepare for the Lord with the holiness and devotion, we hear called for in the second reading, devoting ourselves to making holy our lives and our world in preparation for his coming.

STEWARDSHIP: Advent does not imply a passive waiting, but an active preparation for a new heaven and new earth. Like John the Baptist we must prepare the way of the Lord. We are active co-workers in God's creative plan.

<u>A REMINDER</u>: This Advent is the shortest it can be following last year's longest. Time is not relative when it comes to getting ourselves prepared for the Lord's coming – it is an immediate necessity. Take advantage of the Parish Partnership Advent Reconciliation Service at St. Anthony on Thursday, December 14th at 7pm to get yourself prepared to receive the Lord at Christmas.

A QUESTION FOR THE WEEK: What is the most difficult obstacle I face in preparing a way for Christ to come into my heart anew this Christmas? How can I remove this obstacle?


