

As we continue our Lenten journey today, we hear stories of two significant journeys in the history of our faith. Abraham travels to a distant land with his precious son, Isaac, where his devotion and obedience to God will be put to their greatest test. Jesus leads his closest disciples up a high mountain where he will be transfigured in glory. May our practice of the Lenten disciplines of fasting, prayer, and almsgiving transform us into more loving and devoted disciples.

THIS WEEK'S SCRIPTURE LESSON: Old Testament meets New Testament in today's Gospel, which features Jesus, the center of the New Testament, with two of the main figures from the Hebrew scriptures, Moses and Elijah. The two people who perhaps best represent the law and the prophets of old join with the Son of God, who himself said that he had come to fulfill the law and the prophets. In the company of Moses and Elijah, Jesus is transfigured, giving his disciples a brief taste of his glory. May that glorious vision sustain us during this penitential season.

**STEWARDSHIP:** Stewardship is an expression of our devotion to God. Being faithful and trusting in God's powerful role in our daily lives, demonstrates our love and service to God. We are stewards not only of our personal vocations, but also of our Church. We are challenged during Lent to understand our stewardship in terms of service and fidelity.

**A REMINDER:** Jesus' Transfiguration can help us to experience in our own lives a "transformation" into the graces and holiness that God sets before us to help us "follow the Commandments" (the Law) and "hear the Word" (the Prophets) to achieve fullness of life both here and in the "life to come".

**<u>A QUESTION FOR THE WEEK:</u>** How do I think God would want my life to be transfigured this Lent? Am I willing to accept that change to my life?
