Dear Friends,

During the Easter season, we hear how the disciples encounter the Risen Christ at different times and in different ways, all the while trying to understand the meaning of the Resurrection. We too contemplate the implications of the Resurrection and consider how we see the Risen Lord in our lives. It helps us to gather as Church, where we can seek the presence of Christ as we worship: in the assembly, in its ministers, in the word of God, in the Holy Sacrifice, and in the Eucharist. Let us pray that we may better discern the Lord in our midst.

<u>THIS WEEK'S SCRIPTURE LESSON</u>: "We are witnesses," Peter says to the crowds, referring to the Risen Lord. We heard him preach repentance for the forgiveness of sins. We know he died for us on the cross. We have seen him glorified by our God. We give witness by keeping his commandments. Luke narrates one of the Risen Lord's appearances to the disciples, in which he calls them witnesses to his resurrection. Assured of his continuing presence, we too are able to sing, "Lord, let your face shine on us."

STEWARDSHIP: Through the Eucharist we enjoy a unique union with Christ and, in Him, with one another. We are called to be a living Eucharist to others as they recognize Christ through our actions, as His stewards.

Christ sometimes seems to hide himself and call out so that I will seek him more eagerly, but often he is simply hidden by my distractions.
