



"I am the bread of life," Jesus tells us in the Gospel today, "whoever comes to me will never hunger." We come to Jesus today, where we encounter him in God's word, proclaimed to our assembly. We see him in those who minister to us at this Mass. We realize his presence in each other as we pray and sing.
