Dear Friends,

Imagine that on this day Jesus sends you and several dozen of your fellow parishioners to nearby towns or neighborhoods to spread the gospel. Today we hear Jesus do just that with seventy-two of his disciples. He empowers them to call for repentance, heal the sick, drive out demons, and preach of the kingdom of God. "The harvest is abundant, but the laborers are few," he tells them then and us now. May God's word inspire us to spread the Good News and may the Eucharist nourish and sustain us as we labor in the fields of the Lord.

**THIS WEEK'S SCRIPTURE LESSON:** Difficulties are many, but our reward is great. Isaiah finds comfort in Jerusalem, our spiritual home, even though at the time it lay in ruins, leading the Israelites to mourn for its prior greatness. Paul bears the marks of his persecution but boasts in the saving cross. Jesus sends his disciples out like lambs among wolves, but they return rejoicing with their successes. Whatever our difficulties are today, may we, like all the earth, cry out to God with joy.

**STEWARDSHIP:** The life of a Christian steward, lived in imitation of the life of Christ, is challenging, even difficult in many ways; but both here and hereafter it is charged with intense joy. Like Paul, the good steward is led to share in the work of proclaiming the Good News in everyday life and can boast of identification with Jesus.

**<u>A REMINDER</u>**: On this Fourth of July Holiday weekend, we celebrate the 249th Anniversary of the founding of our Nation. History, however, indicates that democracies do not stand the test of time. May our experiment in self-governing be the one exception to that rule. But it does take the concerted effort of all people to ensure that the rights and freedoms we so cherish are preserved and defended even in the most challenging of times. God bless the USA.

A QUESTION FOR THE WEEK: How am I willing to labor this week to add to Jesus' harvest?
