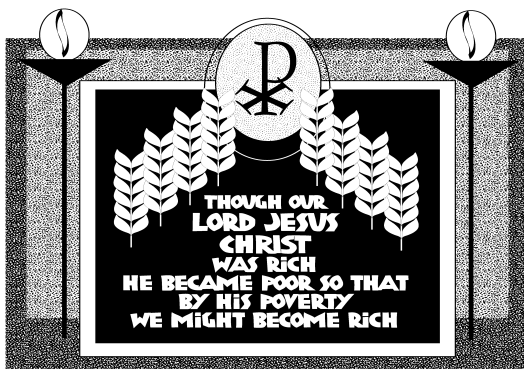

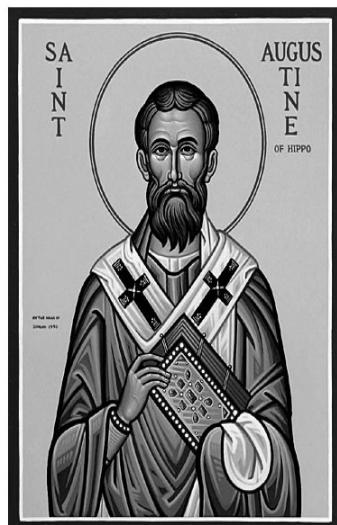

Dear Friends,

"You cannot serve both God and man," we hear Jesus tell his disciples in today's Gospel. He challenges us to decide where our priorities lie. Which do we spend more time and energy building up: our faith or our wealth? It is difficult to ignore the need for money, if only to have enough to get by, let alone pursuing more so that we can live a comfortable life. But we believe our treasure can be found in the kingdom of God, in which money is irrelevant. May today's liturgy remind us of that truth.

THIS WEEK'S SCRIPTURE LESSON: Today's first reading, responsorial psalm, and Gospel speak to the pursuit and use of wealth. Amos decries the merchants who cheat the poor, promising that God will not overlook their selfishness. The psalmist promises that the Lord will lift up the poor and lowly. Jesus teaches his disciples to be trustworthy in handling worldly wealth so that they can be trusted with the true wealth that comes from God. Listening to today's selections from Scripture, let us consider our relationship to material wealth.

STEWARDSHIP: It is often difficult to separate ourselves from the demands and possessions of the world, but there is a tremendous amount of peace that comes from accepting and living out joyfully and generously the commitments, responsibilities, and roles to which God calls us.

A REMINDER: On Sunday we celebrate Catechetical Sunday and its theme: "Always be ready to give an explanation...for a reason for your hope" (1 Peter 3:15). This theme encourages Catholics to be prepared to share the basis of their faith and the hope they find in the Lord, while also emphasizing the importance of gentleness and respect in these conversations. We will be Commissioning our Catechetical and Youth Ministers at the Sunday Masses.

A QUESTION FOR THE WEEK: How do I value true wealth over material wealth? How can I do so more fully?
