Dear Friends,

The Lateran Basilica in Rome, the only church building whose dedication is celebrated as a feast, is an enduring symbol of the universal church. Inscribed on its façade is "omnium urbis et orbis ecclesiarum mater et caput," meaning, "mother and head of all the churches of the city and of the world." Originally completed in 324 CE, soon after Emperor Constantine legalized Christianity, the Lateran Basilica is a sign of the triumph of the faithful who survived underground for generations when Christians were persecuted. Although we likely are gathered in a much humbler setting today, we are nonetheless intimately linked to this historic church—our mother church.

THIS WEEK'S SCRIPTURE LESSON: In his vision of a restored temple in Jerusalem, the holy city—the city of God—Ezekiel sees the life-giving waters that flow from it, bringing life to land and sea. We sing of these waters in the psalm, linking them to God's dwelling. In the Gospel, Jesus refers to his Body as a temple and in the second reading Paul asserts that we are the temple of God, for the Holy Spirit dwells in each of us. Aware of our holiness and each other's holiness, we listen together to God's word. **STEWARDSHIP:** We are inserted in Christ in Baptism. As His disciples, we are invited to identify with Him, especially in His cross, and to live out our discipleship in a concrete, realistic way. Stewardship is an expression of our discipleship, of the fact that we are alive in God.

<u>A REMINDER</u>: Having been in Rome both in 1995 and recently having returned, I can attest to the beauty of this awesome Basilica. As we celebrate it, we celebrate all Catholic Churches throughout the world and recognize (as in the words of St. Paul) our own image as the Body of Christ, His Church. On Tuesday let us pause in a moment of prayer for our Veterans, living and deceased, and be ever grateful for your Service and Sacrifice.

<u>A QUESTION FOR THE WEEK:</u> This coming week, how can I let God's grace flow through me to bring life to someone who's parched or empty in some way?
