Dear Friends,

"Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand!" So proclaimed John the Baptist as he prepared the world for the coming of the Messiah. We may not be preparing for Jesus Christ's arrival in the flesh or plung-ing into the Jordan River, but John's words apply just as much today as they did then. We must recognize and repent of our sins in order to be prepared for the Lord's arrival in our lives in any way. And the kingdom of heaven is still at hand, glimpsed when we are reconciled with God and our neighbor. May we hear John's words as if they were directed to us here and now.

THIS WEEK'S SCRIPTURE LESSON: Each Sunday of Advent this year, the first reading is taken from the book of the prophet Isaiah and the Gospel is from Matthew. Matthew's Gospel consistently portrays Jesus and his mission as a fulfillment of the promise God made to the Chosen People. Therefore, Matthew strives to connect the dots between Isaiah, the paramount prophet of the Hebrew scriptures, and Jesus Christ. Today we hear Isaiah and John the Baptist describe in terms poetic and practical the coming of God's chosen one. May their words strengthen our anticipation of and preparation for the Lord's coming.

<u>STEWARDSHIP</u>: We can derive hope from the Scriptures, because God wishes human beings to be His collaborators in the work of creation, redemption and sanctification; and such collaboration involves Stewardship in its most profound sense.

<u>A REMINDER</u>: This weekend please welcome Fr. Jim Nall as the celebrant for the Masses at both parishes, as I attend the Winter Illinois State Council Knights of Columbus Organizational meeting in Peoria. Please keep our First Communicants in your prayers as they will be receiving their First Reconciliation on Wednesday, December 10th in St. Dominic Church at 6:45pm. This year the Prolife Night of Prayer will only be one hour from 7-8pm and will be held in St. Augustine Church. Please come and spend one hour in prayer and adoration of the Blessed Sacrament for the end to abortion and other life threatening issues.
