

Dear Friends,

During the forty-day journey through the desert that we make each Lent, again and again we will find ourselves tempted to do the wrong thing, to overindulge, to lie, to take the easy way out. Fortunately, the Holy Spirit accompanies us to guide us along the right path and lead us back after we lose our way. We recall that filled with the Holy Spirit, Jesus was able to resist temptation on his journey, even when the devil offered him the whole world. May we be strengthened regularly by his Body and Blood while on our holy pilgrimage.

THIS WEEK'S SCRIPTURE LESSON: On the first Sunday of Lent, we are reminded how easy it is to succumb to temptation. We are faced with it every day and it seems magnified during Lent. Today, we hear how Adam and Eve gave in to temptation while Jesus resisted it. Jesus found strength in the word of God, which he used effectively to outduel the devil in the desert. Let us listen now to God's powerful word, aware that Jesus' use of it to resist temptation enables us to share in his righteousness.

STEWARDSHIP: In today's culture, there is a seductive tendency to privatize faith, to push it to the margins of society, confining it to people's hearts or, at best, their homes, while excluding it from the marketplace of ideas where social policy is formed and men and women acquire their view of life and its meaning. Jesus invites us to respond to the challenge of stewardship: to Cherish, proclaim, and foster the gifts of all, while using our personal gifts to serve the community of faith.

A REMINDER: In the Order of Christian Initiation of Adults (OCIA, formerly RCIA) on the First Sunday of Lent, the Church celebrates the Rite of Election at the Cathedral of the diocese. This year we have two Catechumens, one from St. Augustine, Randall Dieck, and one from St. Anthony, Lydon Barwick. We will be celebrating the "Rite of Sending" at both parishes this Sunday, sending Randall and Lydon to the Cathedral in Belleville to be enrolled.

A QUESTION FOR THE WEEK: How do I resist temptation? Can I remember to look ahead to the long-term consequences before I choose what to do?
