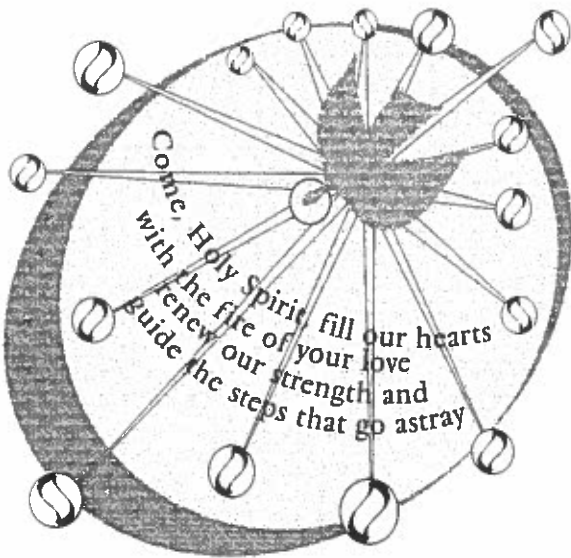

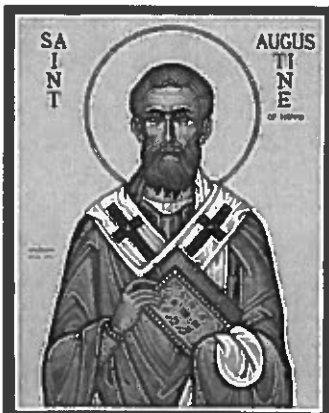
**Reconciliation:** Seasonal penance services offered throughout the year, on Saturday at 3:30 pm at St. Augustine Church or by appointment at any time.

We invite everyone 18 or older to register at the office as adults.

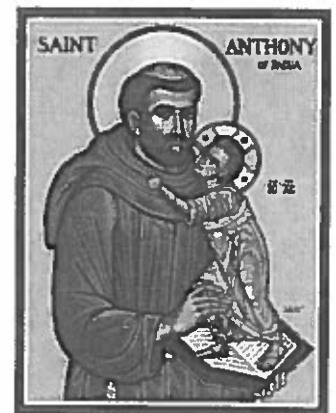

Dear Friends,

Today we bring to a close this joyous fifty-day season that follows Easter Sunday. We praise God, who having raised Jesus from the dead, now sends the Holy Spirit to enliven our hearts and remain with us forever. We seek to make the Spirit manifest in today's world through our energy and creativity, our attitudes and actions.

**THIS WEEK'S SCRIPTURE LESSON:** In the Vigil Gospel for Pentecost, John explains that Jesus was referring to the Holy Spirit when he spoke of living water flowing within those who believe in him. The readings recall a time when the Holy Spirit had not yet come into the world; therefore, that thirst for living water was still unquenched. Aware that the Spirit flows through us now, let us listen to the longing for that life-giving Spirit during the centuries before Jesus was glorified. The Gospel for the day of Pentecost reminds us of the beginnings of the Church and how the fearful followers of Jesus became fearless in proclaiming the Good News.

**STEWARDSHIP:** We are obliged to be stewards of the Church - collaborators and cooperators in continuing the redemptive work of Jesus Christ, which is the Church's essential mission. This mission - proclaiming and teaching, serving and sanctifying is our task. It is the personal responsibility of each one of us as stewards of the Church.

**A REMINDER:** Today we celebrate our birth as a Church and our call to be brave and strong witnesses to the faith. It is a renewal of our Baptismal promise through Confirmation. We still have not received word as to when we will be able to gather for the Sacrament of Confirmation for our Eighth graders nor when we will be able to celebrate First Communion with our Second graders. Let us keep these young people in our prayers as they await these Sacraments in their Faith Journey.

**A QUESTION FOR THE WEEK:** Do I rely on the Holy Spirit for guidance? When I search my heart, what stubbornness do I find that could use honest examination?

**On Saturday, July 11<sup>th</sup>, at 10:30 AM, in the Cathedral of St. Peter, I will Ordain  
The Rev. Mr. Nicholas T. Fleming, The Rev. Mr. Carl E. Schrage, and The Rev. Mr.  
Joel L. Seipp to the Priesthood of Jesus Christ.**

The Ordination was originally scheduled for May 30<sup>th</sup>, the Vigil of Pentecost. This change has been caused by complications due to the coronavirus pandemic. At this point I warmly invite all of you join us in prayers to the Holy Spirit on this important moment in the life of our Local Church.

During this same Mass, the Sacred Chrism will be blessed. Priests and Deacons who join us in prayer will be able to take the oils for their parishes with them. Or, they may be picked up at a later date. The oils will NOT be distributed to parish representatives during the Mass.

It is my hope and prayer that, by then, it will be possible for a number of people to participate in this important Diocesan liturgy. However, as the date approaches, we may be given directives from the Governor's Office to limit the number of participants for the health and safety of all. This is a fluid situation. I will inform you as soon as I know. If attendance is constrained by the coronavirus, the Ordination will still take place on July 11<sup>th</sup> with the *Ordinandi* joined by their immediate families and representatives of the priests.
