



Dear Friends.

Before he gave his body and blood on the cross for the salvation of the whole world, Jesus gave his body and blood to his disciples in the form of bread and wine, instructing them to continue this practice in memory of him. Like the Lord providing water and manna in the desert, Jesus provides food and drink to sustain us, taking it one step further by transforming it to his own Body and Blood. As we receive the Eucharist today, let us realize the sustenance we are given. May the Eucharist we share today strengthen and enliven us as we bring Jesus with us to the world.

THIS WEEK'S SCRIPTURE LESSON: The readings today not only remind us that God has provided us with food to strengthen and sustain us, but also that this food is unfamiliar and unique. Moses points out that the manna the Lord provided in the desert was "unknown to you and your fathers." Jesus tells the crowds that the food and drink he provides is his flesh and blood, previously unknown to be food at all. As we receive the Eucharist today, let us appreciate the uniqueness of this true food.

STEWARDSHIP: Through Eucharist, we enjoy a unique union with Christ and, in Him, with one another. His love indeed, His very self - flows into His disciples and, through them and their practice of stewardship, to the entire human race. In the Eucharist, we reaffirm our participation in the New Covenant; we give thanks to God for blessings received; and we strengthen our bonds of commitment to one another as members of the covenant community Jesus forms.

<u>A REMINDER:</u> We were happy to be able to open our doors for Masses last weekend, even though we are celebrating in the two gyms. This allows us to use the greater of capacity limits of 25% or 100 whichever is less. We have 100 chairs set six feet apart at both gyms and we have two awesome parishes teams that are working diligently to make sure of your health and safety needs. It is amazing that our two parishes with great cooperation from individuals were able to provide all the necessary procedures required for us to open at such a short notice when we did. *THANK YOU!*
