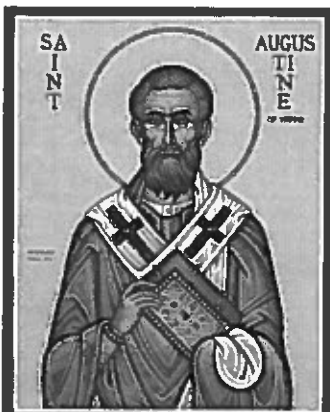
**Reconciliation:** Seasonal penance services offered throughout the year, on Saturday at 3:30 pm at St. Augustine Church or by appointment at any time.

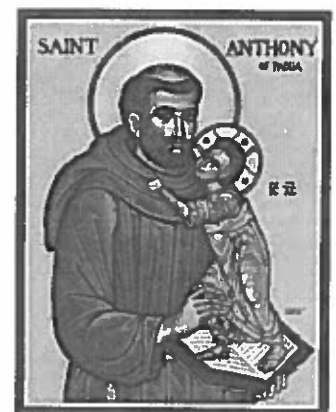

Dear Friends,

As we honor our fathers today we hear Jesus reassure his disciples by reminding them of the tender care of his heavenly Father. Our heavenly Father watches over us assiduously, faithfully, lovingly; every hair on our heads is accounted for. Let us recall all the times our own fathers, grandfathers, uncles, and father figures—living and deceased—made us feel safe and secure with their vigilant care.

**THIS WEEK'S SCRIPTURE LESSON:** When television networks interrupt their regular programming with an urgent report, they close by saying something to the effect of, "We now return you to our regularly scheduled program already in progress." Today we return to the Gospel of Matthew, already in progress. We have not heard from Matthew in over two months. Were it not for the "special report" of Easter, Pentecost, and other solemnities, we would have just heard Jesus send his twelve disciples on their mission. Their marching orders are quite intimidating, so today we hear Jesus reassure them as they prepare to depart. May his words reassure us as well.

**STEWARDSHIP:** The stewardship of disciples is not reducible only to one task or another. It involves embracing, cultivating, enjoying, sharing and sometimes also giving up the goods of human life. Christians live this way in the confidence that comes from faith: for they know that the human goods they cherish and cultivate will be perfected and they themselves will be fulfilled in that kingdom, already present, which Christ will bring to perfection and one-day hand over to the Father.

**A REMINDER:** On this Father's Day weekend we extend our prayerful best regards and deepest gratitude to the fathers of the parish for their loving commitment to their families. Our two parish's Catholic Services and Ministry Appeal goals were lowered this year to better reflect a more equitable amount that could be attained. **Congratulations to St. Anthony, Beckemeyer for surpassing their goal with a current pledge of \$4,744.00 or 105%.** Currently St. Augustine is at 79% of its goal with a current pledge of \$5,678.50 or \$1,567.50 more needed to reach their goal. I cannot think of a more awesome way to greet our new Bishop-elect Michael McGovern than for both parishes to welcome him by their attaining their goals to further the services and ministries that the Diocese needs to provide. We are almost there, *let's have an exerted effort at St. Augustine to make it happen.*

**A QUESTION FOR THE WEEK:** When am I unwilling to stand up for what I believe? What fears prevent me from bringing my faith into the light?
