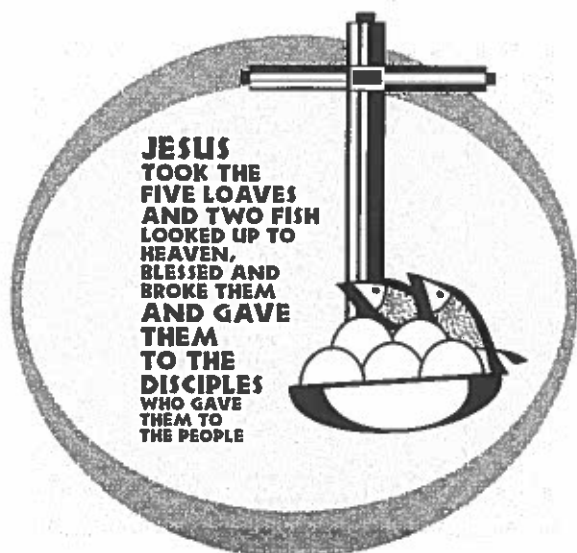

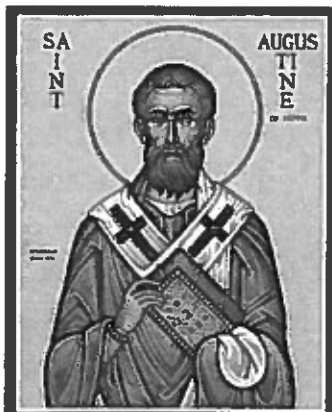
Reconciliation: Seasonal penance services offered throughout the year, on Saturday at 3:30 pm at St. Augustine Church or by appointment at any time.

We invite everyone 18 or older to register at the office as adults.

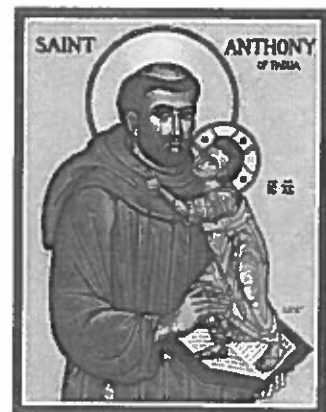

Dear Friends,

Thousands of people, many of them sick and all of them hungry, walked for miles from towns throughout Galilee just to see and hear Jesus. How fortunate we are that Jesus is with us here whenever we gather in his name. He nourishes us at this table, strengthening our weaknesses and fortifying us for our own journeys. Let us pray today that we may all eat and be satisfied at this Eucharist.

THIS WEEK'S SCRIPTURE LESSON: "The hand of the Lord feeds us," we sing in today's responsorial psalm, and today's readings attest to this proclamation. In Isaiah, the Lord invites everyone to share in food and drink. In the Gospel, Jesus invites the crowds to stay and feeds thousands with five loaves and two fish. Neither hunger nor thirst, poverty nor want, famine nor distress can separate us from the love and generosity of the Lord. Let us listen to God's word knowing that we are invited to the feast as well.

STEWARDSHIP: Today's readings focus on the fact that everything we have is a gift from God. Through our practice of stewardship, we recognize God as the Origin of life, the Giver of freedom, the Source of all we have and are and will be. We are deeply aware of the truth that "The hand of the Lord feeds us; he answers all our needs." We know ourselves to be recipients and caretakers of God's many gifts. We are grateful for what we have received and eager to cultivate our gifts out of love for God and one another.
