Sun. 8:30 am St. Anthony 10:00 am St Augustine





Dear Friends,

We are the Church, the universal assembly of believers, the Body of Christ, called to build the kingdom of God. Each of us is part of this institution that can be traced back nearly two thousand years to Saint Peter's commissioning by Jesus, the rock on whom we are built. As we celebrate the Eucharist today, let us reflect on this awesome privilege of being a part of this two-thousand-year-old mission and contemplate what we are called to do to bring it closer to perfection.

This Week's Scripture Lesson: Jesus poses a question to his disciples today: "Who do you say that I am?" Throughout our lives we have learned about Jesus from parents and teachers, from the word of God we hear proclaimed each week, from those in whom we see the face of Christ in our world. Peter's answer is that Jesus is the Christ (literally, the Messiah), the Son of the living God. Let us contemplate our own answer as we listen to today's readings. Stewardship: Jesus asked his disciples for their perception of His identity. We all have an identity before God: the Christian life starting with baptism that we did not create and that we cannot obliterate. We can seriously hamper its effectiveness in our life by sin, but we can never change our Christian identity - who we are and what we are. Stewardship invites us to live out our God-given identity in a spirit of generosity.

A REMINDER: Please keep in your prayers our seven Second graders who are preparing to receive their First Holy Communion at St. Anthony. May their hearts always be filled with joy in receiving Jesus in the Eucharist and may our hearts do as well. Parishioners of St. Augustine, let us celebrate in our lives and hearts the up-coming feasts of St. Monica on Thursday and St. Augustine on Friday. Unfortunately, <u>no</u> Ice Cream Social this year due to Covid-19 food restrictions in parishes.
