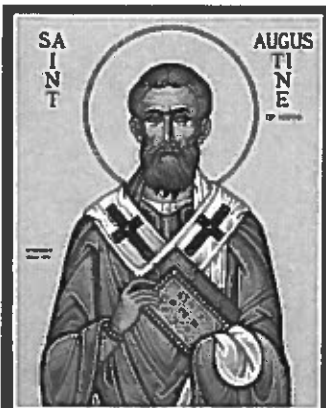
Reconciliation: Seasonal penance services offered throughout the year, on Saturday at 3:30 pm at St. Augustine Church or by appointment at any time.

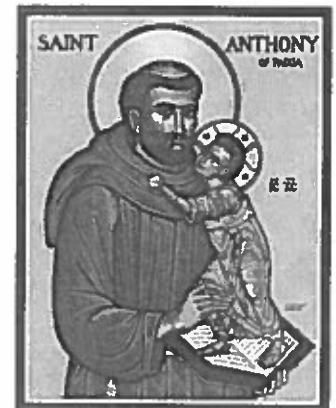

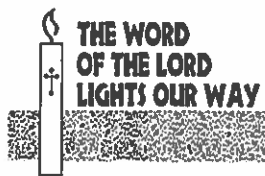

Dear Friends,

In today's second reading, Saint Paul calls upon the Philippians to "(be) of the same mind, with the same love, united in heart, thinking one thing." We come here today probably each thinking different things, but during this holy time together we pray that the Holy Spirit may unite us in heart and mind, with the love of God and love of neighbor we have in common, as we lift our voices to sing and pray as one.

THIS WEEK'S SCRIPTURE LESSON: Ezekiel exhorts his audience to turn back to God, that in so doing they will save their lives. Jesus tells the chief priests and the elders that those who obey God will enter the kingdom of God. Paul suggests a model in Jesus, who humbled himself to do his Father's will. Let us listen to the word of God, asking for God's mercy for our failings and God's grace to change our minds and hearts.

STEWARDSHIP: Stewards must constantly beg God for the grace of conversion: the grace to know who we are, to whom we belong, how we are to live - the grace to repent and change and grow, the grace to become good disciples. God's love is always there.
