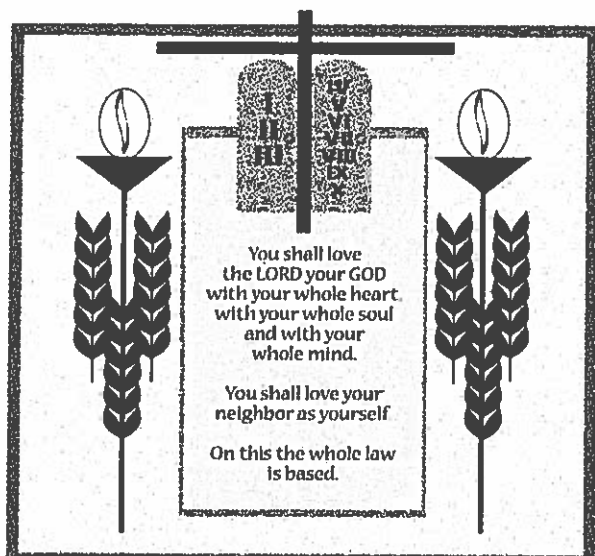

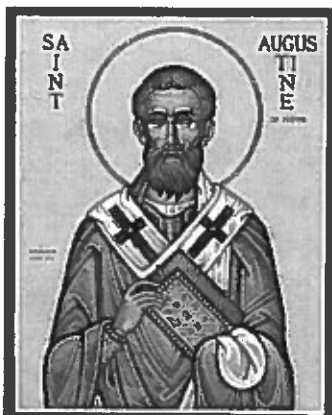
**Reconciliation:** Seasonal penance services offered throughout the year, on Saturday at 3:30 pm at St. Augustine Church or by appointment at any time.

We invite everyone 18 or older to register at the office as adults.

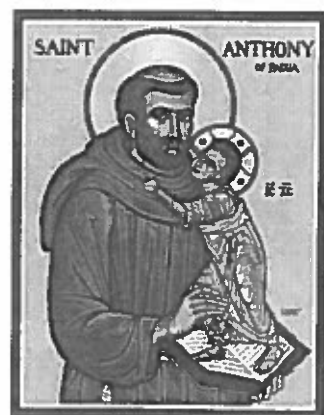

Dear Friends,

Today we hear the Lord remind the Israelites of their past, where they'd come from and what they overcame. We come here today as we are now, but we must recall who we were in the past, what we have accomplished and what we have overcome. We can empathize with our neighbor, for the joys, difficulties, and worries she is experiencing today are comparable to what we have ourselves experienced. Let us thank God for the grace that brought us here today and the continued grace to see ourselves in our neighbor.

**THIS WEEK'S SCRIPTURE LESSON:** In today's first reading, God commands the Chosen People to act fairly and compassionately to their neighbor and warns them of the consequences if they do not. In the Gospel, Jesus tells the Pharisees that love of God and love of neighbor take precedence over every other commandment. Let us pray for the grace to treat our neighbor as we treat ourselves so that we can be like the Thessalonians, whom Saint Paul calls "a model for all the believers".

**STEWARDSHIP:** In Exodus, God exhorts the community of faith to show compassion to those who are most in need. Jesus tells the people of God, formed by the New Covenant, to love God and to place themselves at the service of the entire human community by loving neighbor as self. Each member of the Church shares in responsibility for its mission; each is called to practice stewardship.

**A REMINDER:** As we find ourselves in the midst of our Fall Season and the beautiful foliage begins to lose its colors and the leaves fall to the earth depleted of life, we are reminded of our own life cycle: The Springtime of our youth, the Summer of our adulthood, the Fall of our latter years and the inevitable Winter of our death. The mystery of death truly lies in the words of Jesus, "unless the seed falls to the ground and dies, it cannot bear fruit". The fullness of our life is not here but with God forever in heaven.

**A QUESTION FOR THE WEEK:** In what ways am I a model for other believers, as the Thessalonians were? What can I do to model the greatest commandments to others?
