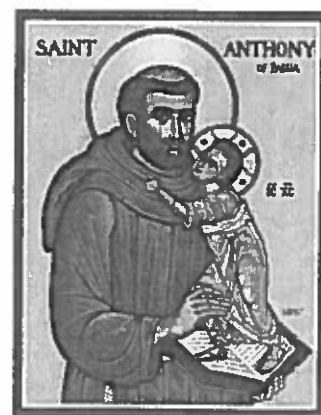
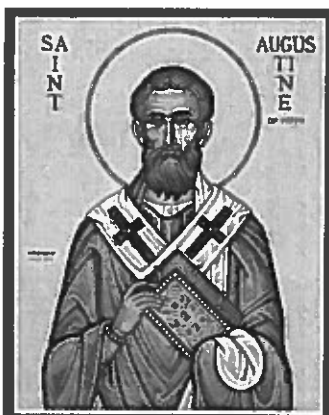

Dear Friends,

In today's Gospel, we hear the familiar passage in which the Son of Man separates the sheep from the goats, explaining to them that what they did (or failed to do) for the least of their neighbors, they did (or failed to do) for him. Joined here today as a community of faith, let us look for the Lord in our neighbor, welcoming Christ in the stranger, providing for him in the needy, comforting him in the suffering, befriending him in the lonely, and exulting with him with those who are filled with joy.

THIS WEEK'S SCRIPTURE LESSON: On this final Sunday of the liturgical year the readings concern the end of time and Christ's role as king and judge. Before Jesus spoke to his disciples about separating sheep from goats, Ezekiel prophesied about the sheep God tends and then judges. Paul explained how at the end of time all will be brought to life and death will be destroyed. Finally, we hear Matthew's account of the Last Judgment. As we listen, let us ask ourselves if we can see the face of Jesus in those in need and pray for the grace to respond.

STEWARDSHIP: God's kingdom already is present in history, imperfect but real. In Christ, God has entered fully into human life and history. A Christian steward builds God's kingdom in continuity with this present life through the human goods and worthy human purposes. The steward has absolute trust that God will perfect human goods and bring about the final fulfillment of human persons.

A REMINDER: As we approach Thanksgiving on Thursday, our Thanksgiving Masses will be on Wednesday, November 25th, at 7pm in St. Augustine gym and on Thursday, Thanksgiving Day, at 8:30am in St. Anthony gym. Let us be grateful for all the bountiful gifts God has bestowed upon us.

A QUESTION FOR THE WEEK: Who have I ignored or overlooked that I can reach out to now in mercy? At Thanksgiving, who can I thank for reaching out to me in my need this year?
