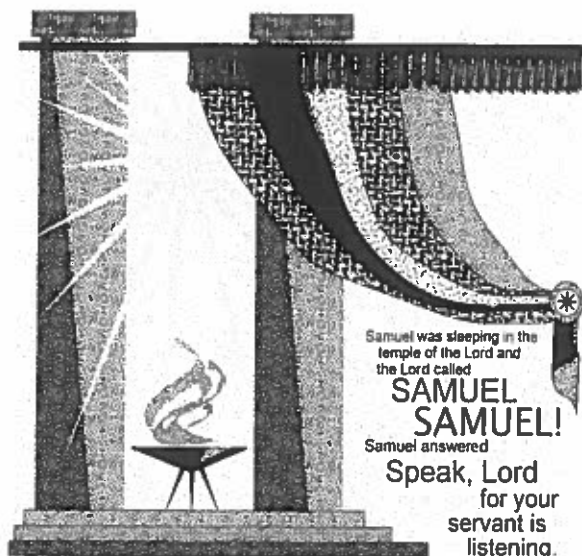

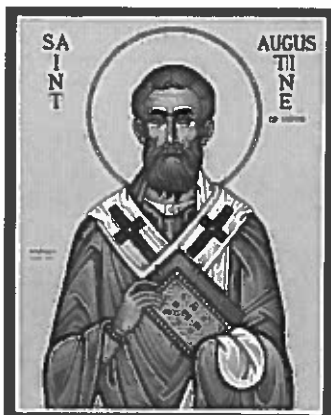
Reconciliation: Seasonal penance services offered throughout the year, on Saturday at 3:30 pm at St. Augustine Church or by appointment at any time.

We invite everyone 18 or older to register at the office as adults.

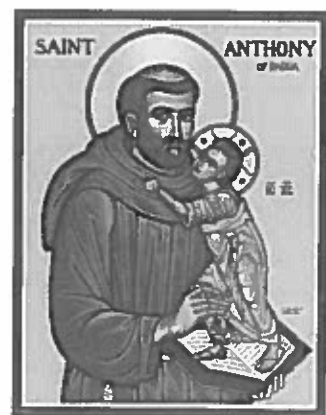

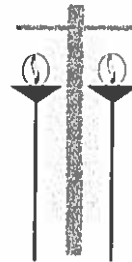

Dear Friends,

Today's Gospel features Jesus calling his first disciples. The invitation is welcoming and intriguing: "Come, and you will see." How are we called by the Lord? The Lord has called us all here today on this Sunday in the middle of January and so we have come together to listen to God's word and to receive our Lord in the Eucharist. How is the Lord speaking to us today?

THIS WEEK'S SCRIPTURE LESSON: God calls Samuel in the middle of the night in today's first reading. Samuel is confused, but eventually he responds, "Speak, for your servant is listening." John's disciples are listening when he points to Jesus and says, "Behold, the Lamb of God." They follow Jesus at once. Let us listen to God's word, ponder how we ourselves are called, and recommit ourselves to following the Lord.

STEWARDSHIP: Today we hear Samuel respond eagerly, "Here I am!" each time the Lord calls him. May we, too, be listening for the call of God in our lives and be ready to say like Samuel, "Speak, for your servant is listening."

A REMINDER: January 18-25 is the Annual Week of Prayer for Christian Unity. The theme for this year is "Abide in my love...you shall bear much fruit" (taken from John 15). Due to the Covid-19 pandemic and restrictions, it has been decided to cancel the Community Ecumenical Service this year – but to have some special prayer at each of the Churches sometime during this week. We will have our special prayer for Christian Unity during the Masses at both parishes next weekend, January 23/24. Friday, January 22, is the annual Day of Prayer for the Legal Protection of Unborn Children – we will be commemorating the 22nd at our Friday morning Mass at St. Augustine at 8am. Please join us as we Pray for Life.

A QUESTION FOR THE WEEK: How can I discern the Lord's call among the many voices in my life? Is there an intermediary I can trust to recognize the Lord's voice?
