





Dear Friends.

"Lord, have mercy," we pray at the beginning of Mass, calling upon the Lord to have mercy on us in our sinfulness. Today we celebrate that divine mercy, the mercy that is stronger than any fault, any wrong, any sin, the mercy that always seeks to reconcile us with the Lord, the mercy that led God to send the Son to win us our salvation. Let us rejoice that we are always able to receive that tender mercy.

THIS WEEK'S SCRIPTURE LESSON: Today's Gospel features the story of "doubting Thomas," the apostle who refused to believe in the risen Christ until he saw him with his own eyes. But let us not overlook Jesus giving the Holy Spirit to the apostles, telling them "whose sins you forgive are forgiven them." May we be a forgiving people, calling upon the Holy Spirit, whom we received in baptism, to extend that divine mercy to all in need of forgiveness, to all of us.

<u>STEWARDSHIP</u>: We celebrate our unity with each other through the sharing of our gifts. Through Eucharist, Christ's love indeed, His very Self - flows into us, His disciples today, and through us, and our practice of Stewardship, to the entire human race. We are called to be Stewards of the Church today.

<u>A REMINDER:</u> The Divine Mercy Chaplet is a beautiful prayer that the Church prays at 3pm each day, but can be prayed at any time. There is a video Prayer Service on our two parish websites that has the Chaplet that you can pray along with.
