



Dear Friends.

"In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit." We say this when we enter a church, when we begin Mass, when we pray. It is our identity. It reminds us that we are in the presence of God. It joins us to millions of other Christians across time and space. It expresses our belief in the Triune God. Three persons in one God enabled God to become incarnate, enabled God to come down upon us in baptism, and enables God to be with us here today and every day. Let us contemplate the great wonders God has done and continues to do in our daily lives.

THIS WEEK'S SCRIPTURE LESSON: As he says farewell to his disciples, Jesus instructs them to baptize "in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit." Nearly twenty full centuries later we were baptized with the same words. God the Father, whom Moses extols in the first reading, God the Son, who calls us to discipleship in the Gospel, and God the Holy Spirit, whom Paul says bears witness to our adoption as children of God, mark our identity as Christians. We are reminded of this every time we make the sign of the cross. Listening to God's holy word, let us reflect on the blessings we receive from the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.

STEWARDSHIP: The stewardship way of life challenges us to recognize God as Creator of all gifts, follow Jesus as Giver of life, and witness the Holy Spirit as Leader in our lives.

A REMINDER: Please extend a warm welcome to Fr. Joel Seipp as he celebrates your Masses this weekend; I will be attending the Illinois State Council Knights of Columbus Convention in Lombard. On this Memorial Day weekend, let us pause and remember our beloved departed, especially those men and women who were killed in the line of duty whether serving our Country in the Armed Services or serving our communities as civil servants and first responders. May they rest in the Peace of the Lord and may their memories be a blessing. There will be a Cemetery Mass at both our Cemeteries on Monday at 9 am. Fr. Pat will be at the St. Augustine/St. Dominic Cemetery and I will be at the St. Anthony Cemetery.
