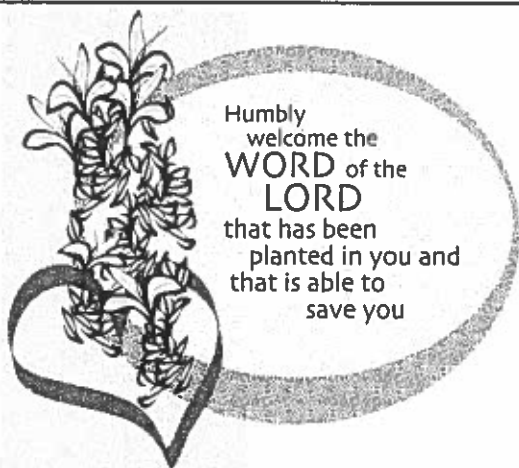

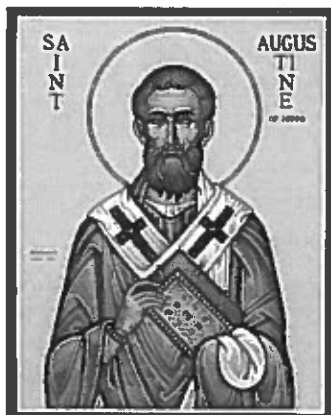
Reconciliation: Seasonal penance services offered throughout the year, on Saturday at 3:30 pm at St. Augustine Church or by appointment at any time.

Dear Friends,

The greatest gift each of us has ever received was the gift of life itself. That gift was given to us most directly by our parents, whose life in turn was given to them by their parents, and so on. But ultimately the author of all life, the giver of every great gift, is God. We come together today in thanksgiving for that precious gift, which led to the gift of eternal life, promised by God's Son to all who follow him.

THIS WEEK'S SCRIPTURE LESSON: Do we take God's word to heart and act upon it? Moses - about to reveal the commandments - calls on the people to observe God's word carefully and faithfully. In his letter, James asks us to welcome God's word and put it into action. In the Gospel, Jesus warns the scribes and Pharisees that they confuse human tradition with God's commands. Listening to God's word, let us consider how it guides our actions.

STEWARDSHIP: A life of stewardship depends on the realization that everything we possess is a gift from God and belongs to God. We are all stewards or managers of the many gifts God has bestowed upon us. Our challenge as Christians is to make good use of those gifts.

A REMINDER: This weekend we remember the patron of St. Augustine of Hippo parish and his mother, St. Monica. Her patience, prayers and love led to his conversion. Redemption is not lost on anyone and even though their journey to Grace may take many years of pain and sorrow – the end result is Glory forever in God's Presence.

A QUESTION FOR THE WEEK: What will I do this week to put God's word into action? Has God's word truly penetrated my heart?
