





Dear Friends,

We rejoice as we begin the second half of this season of preparation, for we realize that the Lord is already in our midst. While remembering our Lord's birth over two thousand years ago and looking forward to his coming again in glory at the end of time, we prepare our hearts for his presence here today, praying that every day we can express his good news in what we say and do. May our words and actions witness to the world the true meaning of Christ's birth.

**THIS WEEK'S SCRIPTURE LESSON:** Today we have the opportunity to hear John the Baptist's counsel to the crowds of people filled with expectation of the imminent coming of the long-awaited Messiah. Three times in today's Gospel they ask John, "What should we do?" Let us heed John's responses, for who better to prepare us for his coming into our world than the one who first prepared the world for his coming?

**STEWARDSHIP:** John the Baptizer urged his listeners to be good stewards: "Let the man with two coats give to him who has none. The man with food should do the same. As followers of Jesus, we are called to a comprehensive view of stewardship -- a vision of a sharing, generous, accountable way of life rooted in discipleship. Stewardship means that we help advance the Church's mission with money, time, and personal resources of all kinds.
