



Dear Friends.

Quite likely you have a long checklist of things that you need to do before Christmas, which is now only three weeks away. But is "repentance for the forgiveness of sins" on that list? It ought to be, for this is exactly what John the Baptist called for in preparation for the Lord's coming. Gathered here today to receive Jesus in the Eucharist, let us repent of the wrongs we have done or failed to do and seek forgiveness for our sins so as to properly prepare a place for our Lord to be born into our lives.

THIS WEEK'S SCRIPTURE LESSON: We hear from both Baruch and Isaiah today, the latter through Luke's description of John the Baptist's work, challenging and comforting the people of Israel. Baruch calls the people back to Jerusalem, where they will be "wrapped in the cloak of justice." Isaiah promises that when the Lord comes, "all flesh shall see the salvation of God." Let us prepare for the Lord's coming, assured that justice and salvation are nigh.

STEWARDSHIP: Stewardship is an invitation to learn to value the things that really matter. The glory and boast of Christian stewards lie in mirroring, however poorly, the stewardship of Jesus Christ, who gave and still gives all He has and is, in order to be faithful to God's will and carry through to completion His redemptive stewardship of human beings and their world. A REMINDER: Please welcome Fr. Joel Seipp to the Masses this weekend, as I attend the Knights of Columbus State meeting in Bloomington this weekend. December 8th is the Holyday of the Immaculate Conception (see Mass schedule below). Night of Prayer for Life will be held this year at St. Anthony this Thursday from 6-10pm. How are valleys filled in, mountains made low, paths made straight, and rough ways smoothed? Through: *Repentance*. It is sin that throws up obstacles on our paths to salvation. Plan ahead to take advantage of our Partnership Advent Reconciliation Service at St. Anthony on Thursday, December 16th.

A QUESTION FOR THE WEEK: For what do I need to repent? Whom do I need to forgive?
