Marriage: Call the parish office at least six months in advance.


Anointing of the Sick : Offered annually. Call the parish office for more information or to schedule an anointing.

Dear Friends,

At this time of year, the forces of nature can buffet us from every side. Drought and forest fires, thunderstorms and floods, tornadoes and hurricanes—anything is possible. If we are in a vulnerable position—in a small boat at sea, for example—we can find ourselves in grave danger. Today we see Jesus calmly approach the disciples during a storm as their boat is tossed about by the wind and waves. As we act to keep ourselves and our loved ones safe this season, let us trust in the Lord, who comes to strengthen and comfort us in times of danger.

THIS WEEK'S SCRIPTURE LESSON: Where do we find the Lord? Elijah did not find God in a strong wind, an earthquake, or a fire, but heard the LORD's summons only in a tiny whispering sound. Peter and the disciples, on the other hand, came to recognize Jesus when he came to reassure them on a stormy Sea of Galilee. Paul's heart broke at his own people's difficulty in finding the Christ in the person of Jesus. May these faith-filled people guide us in our own search for the Lord's presence in our lives. **STEWARDSHIP:** Being a steward means having a profound trust in God - living with trust in God's generosity and a responsible tending of that which God has entrusted to us. If we have such trust God will calm the storms that surround our lives.
