



#### Dear Friends,

In today's first reading, we hear God tell Isaiah, "my house shall be called a house of prayer for all peoples." We are gathered here today in a house of prayer, and so we welcome all people who have come here today to join together to pray to God in praise, in petition, and in thanksgiving. Let us lift up our voices in prayer to our God.

THIS WEEK'S SCRIPTURE LESSON: Who is welcomed to our faith community, to our town, or to our country and who is not? What we hear today from Isaiah, Paul, and Jesus can help us understand God's perspective. Each reading challenges us to break down walls that stand in the way of those who are excluded. In the Gospel, in fact, it is a foreign woman who persuades Jesus to break down the commonly accepted barriers of the day. May God's word challenge us today as much as it did when it was written.

**STEWARDSHIP:** Who is a Christian disciple? One who responds to Christ's call, follows Jesus, and shapes his or her life in imitation of Christ's. Who is a Christian steward? One who receives God's gifts gratefully, cherishes and tends them in a responsible and accountable manner, shares them in justice and love with others, and returns them with increase to the Lord.

<u>A REMINDER:</u> School has now resumed and our children and teens have returned to their classrooms. Let us pray that the Holy Spirit will guild their teachers and inspire our young people to learn their faith, love their faith and live their faith.

<u>A QUESTION FOR THE WEEK:</u> Whom is the message of inclusion in today's readings challenging me to look at differently? How can I be more accepting of others?
