Dear Friends,

"Who do you say that I am?" we hear Jesus ask his disciples today. We are his disciples as well, so we would benefit by imagining him asking us the same thing. Who do you say that Jesus is? We could do worse than echoing Saint Peter's answer: "You are the Christ, the Son of the living God." We know now what Peter could not at the time: that Jesus redeemed us when he died on the cross, that he was raised to eternal life with the Father, and that he is still with us today, particularly as we gather together in his name and receive him in the Eucharist. Let the "Amen" we say be our personal affirmation of Peter's answer.

THIS WEEK'S SCRIPTURE LESSON: In the first reading, Isaiah proclaims that God will give Eliakim the key of the House of David. In the Gospel, Jesus promises Peter the keys to the kingdom of heaven. In Eliakim and Peter, God has found faithful followers who can lead and guide the entire community of believers. Though we have not been given such authority, let us pray that we too may faithfully serve God and guide others by our example.

STEWARDSHIP: Jesus asked his disciples for their perception of His identity. We all have an identity before God: the Christian life starting with baptism that we did not create and that we cannot obliterate. We can seriously hamper its effectiveness in our life by sin, but we can never change our Christian identity - who we are and what we are. Stewardship invites us to live out our God-given identity in a spirit of generosity.

<u>A REMINDER</u>: Jesus is the Son of God – there is no doubt of that when it comes to our faith and trust in Him. Jesus took on our humanity as a sign of our adopted nature with a loving Father. In Jesus' humanity we discover our closeness to God – created in the image and likeness of Him who loves us. Let us always reflect that image of God to others.

A QUESTION FOR THE WEEK: What have I learned about God and God's will through prayer?
