





Dear Friends,

Today we celebrate the feast of the Transfiguration, remembering the day when Jesus was transfigured before the eyes of his closest disciples. On that day, our Lord's glory shone through him like the sun, his whole being shining with light. We recall that on the first day of creation, God transformed the world with light. Let us join Peter, James, and John on this holy mountain, where Jesus, who dwells within us, transforms every darkness in our lives to light.

THIS WEEK'S SCRIPTURE LESSON: Today we hear three different accounts of the Transfiguration. The apocalyptic vision in Daniel foreshadows the event, featuring many of the same elements: clothing as bright as snow, clouds from heaven, and the Son of man. The author of the second letter of Peter writes as an eyewitness to the event. Matthew gives a descriptive account of that day. Let us heed Peter's words and be attentive to God's word and this prophetic message.

STEWARDSHIP: The Synoptic Gospels place the Transfiguration account immediately after Jesus outlines for His closest followers the cost of discipleship. "If you wish to come after me," Jesus says, "you must deny yourself and take up your cross daily and follow me. For if you wish to save your life you will lose it, but if you lose your life for my sake you will save it." The steward understands the paradox that giving up means receiving more.

<u>A REMINDER:</u> We pause from our Ordinary Time (Green) Sundays to celebrate a gift Jesus shared with three of his disciples. For them to behold him in his magnificence – a glimpse of the heavenly vision. One day we also will behold the splendor and beauty of God. What a "Awesome" day that will be!

<u>A QUESTION FOR THE WEEK:</u> Which self-interest of mine will I promise to put aside and what cross will I pledge to carry, transfiguring my life and my little part of the world?
