



#### Dear Friends,

Today we hear Jesus assure his disciples that wherever two or three are gathered in his name, he is there with them. Our confidence in his promise assures us that Jesus is here with us now as we celebrate the Eucharist together. Aware that God is with us in our midst, let us raise our voices and lift our hearts unto the Lord.

**THIS WEEK'S SCRIPTURE LESSON:** Today's readings call us to take responsibility for our neighbor. Ezekiel tells us that the LORD holds him personally responsible for turning others away from evil. Paul instructs the Romans that when we love our neighbor, we fulfill God's law. Jesus teaches his disciples that they must reach out to sinners and seek their repentance. May God's word strengthen us to reach out to our neighbor with love, to reconcile with our sisters and brothers.

**STEWARDSHIP:** Christian stewards are generous out of love as well as duty. They dare not fail in charity and what it entails, and the New Testament is filled with warnings to those who might be tempted to substitute some counterfeit for authentic love. The fundamental pattern in every case is simple and Changeless: "You shall love your neighbor as yourself."

<u>A REMINDER</u>: As we commemorate 9/11 and remember the heroic deeds of those First Responders on that tragic day, the Breese Knights of Columbus through it's "Building the Domestic Church" Program have annually sponsored a "Red, White and Blue" Mass honoring those from our Faith Communities who serve as first responders and those serving and who have served in the military in defense of our Country. This year we are celebrating the Mass at St. Anthony this weekend at 9:30am. May we always be grateful to them for their service, dedication and self-sacrifice.
