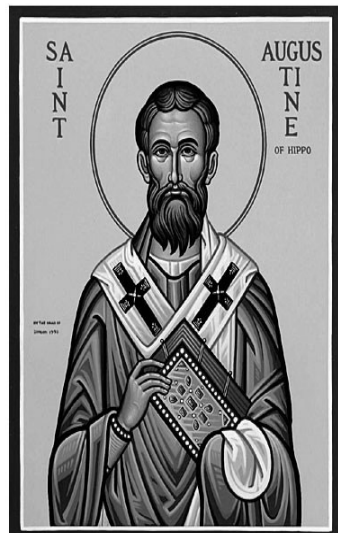

Dear Friends,

We are reminded in today's Gospel what Jesus considered to be the greatest commandments: "Love the Lord, your God, with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind" and "Love your neighbor as yourself." Let us renew our commitment to these commandments, resolving to follow them each and every day. Let us lift our voices in praise of our God, whose greatest command is simply to love.

THIS WEEK'S SCRIPTURE LESSON: How does God want us to act toward others? That question is answered in today's readings. In Exodus, God tells the Chosen People how to treat strangers, widows, orphans, and others in difficult circumstances, and explains why. Writing to the Thessalonians, Paul says that by imitating the Lord they have become models for other believers. In the Gospel, Jesus teaches the Pharisees which commandment is the greatest. Let us allow God's word to penetrate our minds, our souls, and our hearts.

STEWARDSHIP: In Exodus, God exhorts the community of faith to show compassion to those who are most in need. Jesus tells the people of God, formed by the New Covenant, to love God and to place themselves at the service of the entire human community by loving neighbor as self. Each member of the Church shares in the responsibility for its mission; each is called to practice stewardship.

A REMINDER: This weekend on Sunday, we will be remembering our deceased parishioners (10 from St. Augustine and 7 from St. Anthony) who have passed from this earthly existence to a new life with God forever in heaven, May their memories always be a blessing for their families.

A QUESTION FOR THE WEEK: What neighbor do I know who is in need? What can I do for them, even if it's just something simple?
