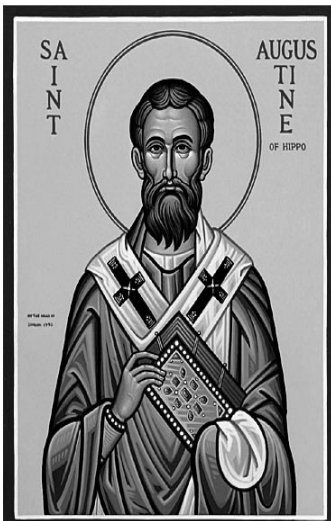

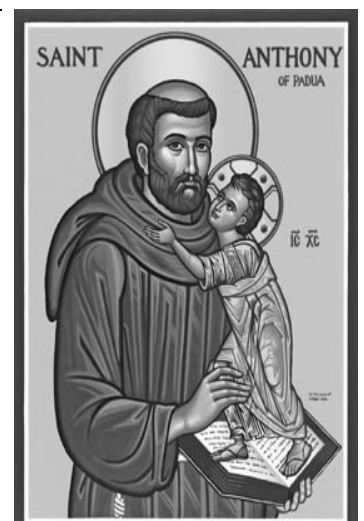

We gratefully and prayerfully remember all those who sacrificed their lives serving our country. This ultimate giving of oneself is the most selfless act of love we humans perform. Also, we have the Ordination of Levi James to the Transitional Diaconate next weekend, Saturday, June 1st. Attend if you can.

Dear Friends,

“Did anything so great ever happen before?” Moses asks in today’s first reading. After celebrating Easter and then Pentecost, we may ask the same question. Throughout Easter Time, which has just come to a close, we recalled how the Son made the ultimate sacrifice for us, the Father raised him from the dead, and then they sent the Holy Spirit to be with us always. Indeed, as we celebrate the Holy Trinity today, we realize that nothing so great as all this has ever happened before. And that those events of two thousand years ago continue to happen for us each day.

THIS WEEK’S SCRIPTURE LESSON: In each of today’s readings, the speaker points out God’s remarkable uniqueness. Moses tells the people that no other god had ever done all the one-of-a-kind wonders that the LORD had done for them. Paul writes that through the Holy Spirit we have been adopted as God’s own children, a relationship with God that is like no other. In telling the disciples to make disciples of all nations, he commands them to baptize in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit, a new way of baptism. How fortunate we are to receive the grace we do from our unique God.

STEWARDSHIP: The stewardship way of life challenges us to recognize God as Creator of all gifts, follow Jesus as Giver of life, and witness the Holy Spirit as Leader in our lives.

A REMINDER: As we commemorate Memorial Day on Monday, let us remember all our fallen heroes who gave so valiantly their lives in defense of democracy. We also invite you to the Memorial Day Masses at our two parishes Cemeteries: 9am at St. Augustine/St. Dominic celebrated by Fr. Pat and 9am at St. Anthony celebrated by Fr. Chuck. In case of inclement weather, the Masses will be moved to St. Augustine and St. Anthony.

A QUESTION FOR THE WEEK: Who is someone I am strongly bonded with? How is our bond suggestive of those of the Trinity? Who is someone I’m barely bonded with? How can I strengthen and nurture that bond?

Parish Update on Priest Replacement and Cluster News:

On April 30th there was a Parish Cluster meeting at St. Dominic Annex. The primary discussions were about Priest retirements/replacements and our Parish Family Partnership (Cluster) preparations.

There have been no decisions shared and/or made about a replacement for Fr. Pat. Since there are five Priests retiring on June 30th the movement and installment of Priests affects the entire Diocese and has made the Diocesan process more complicated. We will share with Parishioners of all three Parishes the news when the Diocese makes it available to us.

Regarding the Cluster formation and Pastoral Partnership Plan – there has been substantial preparation over the last several years. This preparation includes having established a Partnership Mission Statement, By-Laws and Committees with assigned duties. However, the Parish Partnership Council has decided to stop further preparation until the Diocese informs us of their decisions regarding Priest replacements. It was also decided that our current Mass schedules remain unchanged. These decisions were made to avoid the confusion of making changes and then making additional changes when a new Priest or Priests are assigned. Please Pray for Vocations!
